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TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND EXTRAS

□ **Format:**

- 4-person scramble - Each player tees off with their own ball. After all players have hit, the team will select one of the four tee shots and all players will hit their second shot from within one club-length of that placement. You may not move from one playing surface to another, for example: rough to fairway. Play progresses in this same manner until the ball is holed out.
- Each player must use a minimum of three drives over the 18 holes. Keep track of player's drives used on your scorecard.
- On the green, all players putt by placing their ball within 6 inches of the selected ball (usually the shortest putt), but no closer to the hole. First ball in counts, please don't putt out the rest of the balls.
- Record the team score (per hole) on the scorecard.

□ **Hole-In-One Rules** (contest on hole 7):

- **A "HOLE-IN-ONE"**- As defined by the USGA Rules of Golf, must occur by an official registered participant.
- **SHOTS** – No practice shots or mulligans are permitted. One shot per registered tournament player.
- **PRIZE** – There shall be only one (1) maximum prize value paid per target hole.
- **DOCUMENTATION** - Attested statements by the target hole witness of the successful shot maker. A signed and completed original scorecard of the shot maker.

□ **Extras:**



KP (Closest to pin) – There will be men's and women's KP prizes awarded on selected holes.



Longest Drive – There will be men's and women's Longest Drive prizes on selected holes. Drives must be in the fairway to count.



"Pink Lady" – One pink ball per team must be in play at all times on every hole. If a pink ball is lost or hit out of bounds, it is considered out of play and, in the case it was hit out of bounds, cannot be used again. Each team signs (with a sharpie) and turns in their remaining pink balls after 18 holes have been played (assuming they have not all been lost or went out of play). These balls are put into a drawing after all teams have reported in. The golfers' name on the ball that is drawn will be awarded a prize.



String Game – String may be used on the green in lieu of a putt. For example, if a team has a 1-foot putt as their last shot for a hole, they may choose to cut 1-foot off of their remaining length of string (scissors will be provided) and not count that stroke on their scorecard. The 1-foot of string that was used must be disposed of (it cannot be used again on another hole).



Mulligans – Mulligan balloons can be purchased for \$5.00/each and may be used (popped) when a do-over is needed. Golfers may purchase as many Mulligans as desired.
